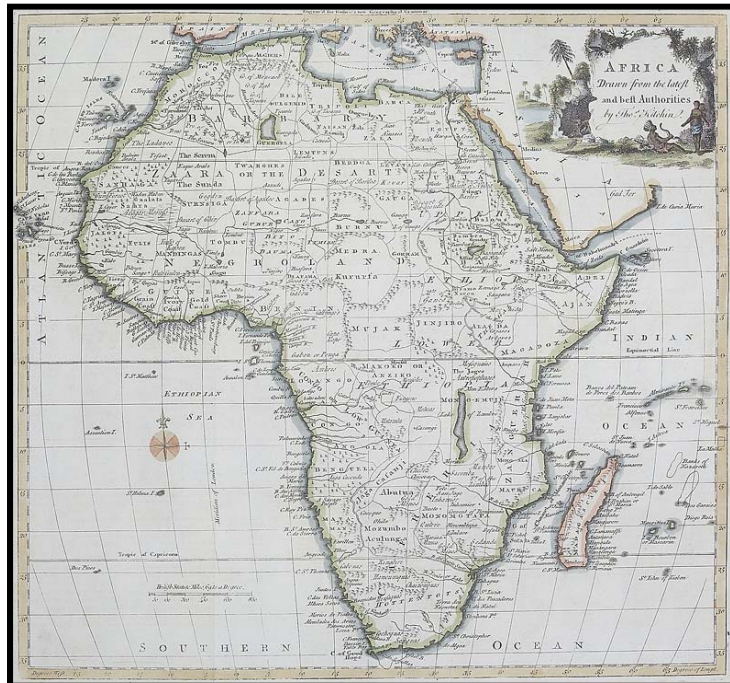


2010 "Southern Africa Indaba" Educational Program

### **SUN MAY 2: DEPART USA FOR SOUTH AFRICA**

Depart from New York (JFK) on South African Airways to Cape Town via Johannesburg. (Domestic USA flights to / from JFK gateway **are not included** - please see South African Airways conditions below).

Arrive at Cape Town International Airport and, after clearing customs and immigration formalities, you will be met by a **Springbok Atlas Tours** representative who will then transfer you to **15 On Orange Hotel** in Cape Town for 2 nights accommodation on a bed and breakfast basis. - Cancellation, baggage, medical or other travel insurance
- Items of a personal nature not specified above
- Meals, entrance fees, taxes, tours, transfers etc. not specified above

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

Only current APTA Individual Members will be considered – preferably at least two from each chapter. Only shared accommodations will be available and to be decided by the sponsors (requests will be honored as far as possible). Accommodation and services will be reserved upon receipt of full payment on a first come first serve basis. All participants will be required to participate on the program for its entirety and will be subject to the terms and conditions of the educational which will be presented to them for signature upon confirmation of their participation. **All participants are required to take out individual travel insurance including trip cancellation, default, baggage, emergency**

**evacuation and medical insurance. All participants are required to sign a release of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity to participate.**

Air, land arrangements, activities and excursions for the educational are subject to change and may be modified due to unforeseen circumstances. The sponsors reserve the right to make such modifications as deemed necessary including substitution of hotels, services, program changes and other tour components as and when necessary. Participants' accommodations at the various different lodges in the Kruger National Park area will be decided by the sponsors.

#### **BOOKING PROCEDURE:**

Once your application and payment has been received and you are accepted to participate on this program you will be informed and your pre departure documents will be emailed to you for completion. You should then apply for your travel insurance and book your own domestic USA air to / from JFK, New York to connect with the confirmed international air. Once we have received the signed copies of your pre departure documents we will then send out your air tickets and any other relevant information.

#### **PAYMENT:**

Please mail the completed application form with your **US check** for the full amount of **\$2,465.00** to **Natural Migrations by February 15, 2010** (see application form for details). Unfortunately, no credit cards can be accepted.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY:**

Cancellation penalties will be 100% of the full price unless a replacement can be found to substitute your participation.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE FROM SOUTH AFRICAN AIRWAYS:**

**Names on air tickets** and names as they appear in passports must be identical. If this is not the case, tickets must be cancelled, penalties applied and reissued. **South African Airways has confirmed space in economy class on May 2<sup>th</sup> and May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2010.** (No upgrades are permitted.) The participants must make **their own way to JFK, New York.**

If you wish to extend your stay in South Africa you will be required to make your own arrangements for any internal flights that you may need. You may do so by logging on to FLYSAA.com to purchase any additional internal flights. Since INDABA is a very busy time of year changing the return flights for passengers wishing to extend their trip will be very difficult. **All additional requests must be made directly with South African Airways.**

#### **TRAVEL INSURANCE:**

Once you have been accepted on the educational you are required to take out your own travel insurance and in order to acquire full travel insurance coverage, **insurance must be obtained within 15 days of your payment being processed to obtain full coverage.** Please contact the insurance company directly to obtain the proper insurance to suit your personal requirements.

#### **PASSPORTS:**

**Visas**, if required, are your responsibility. US citizens do not currently require visas for South Africa or Swaziland. Please visit the following websites for up to date information:

Please ensure that you have at least **3 blank pages** in your passport with **2 pages facing each other**. Insufficient space in the passport will result in entry being denied and the person is likely to be detained pending return to their country of origin. Also passports must be valid for a minimum of **six months** from the return date to the United States.

**Entry/Exit requirements please note:** The passports of all travelers to South Africa must contain at least two blank (unstamped) visa pages each time entry is sought; these pages are in addition to the endorsement/amendment pages at the back of the passport. Otherwise the traveler, even when in possession of a valid South African visa, may be refused entry into South Africa, fined, and returned to their point of origin at the traveler's expense.

#### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**
