Itinerary:

Day 1: Monday (or Saturday) – Nairobi, Kenya

Guests are picked up at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi and transferred to the Holiday Inn Hotel for a one-night stay. *(Alternative hotels may be booked in Nairobi upon request. Please, contact Somak Holidays for a quote, if necessary).* The rest of the day is at leisure. *Meals: breakfast on the following morning.*

Day 2: Tuesday (or Sunday) – Samburu

After breakfast guests are picked up for a drive north through rich farming areas and across the equator to the semi-arid and rugged landscape of the Samburu. After lunch guests proceed on a late-afternoon game drive. Dinner and an overnight stay are at the Ashnil Samburu Camp. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 3: Wednesday (or Monday) – Samburu

Guests take morning and late afternoon game drives in the open savannah which is traversed by the Ewaso Nyiro River. The river is populated by hippos and crocodiles, whilst the park is home to a host of animals, including several species, which are rarely seen in numbers elsewhere, including Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffes and long-necked gerenuks. Overnight stay is at the Ashnil Samburu Camp. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 4: Thursday (or Tuesday) – Aberdares

Guests take a drive south into the Aberdare National Park, and have lunch at the Outspan Hotel, then transfer to Treetops. Guests are advised to limit their luggage to an overnight bag – the remainder can be stored at the Outspan Hotel. Overnight stay is at Treetops (bathroom facilities are shared). *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 5: Friday (or Wednesday) – Lake Naivasha

Guests transfer early in the morning to Outspan Hotel for breakfast and to collect their luggage. Then they descend into the Great Rift Valley and continue to Lake Naivasha Simba Lodge in time for lunch. Then they travel to Lake Nakuru for an afternoon game drive. Overnight stay is at the Lake Naivasha Simba Lodge. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 6: Saturday (or Thursday) – Masai Mara

Guests drive to the Masai Mara National Reserve. Then they go for an afternoon game drive. Overnight stay is at the Ashnil Mara Camp. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 7: Sunday (or Friday) – Masai Mara

An early-morning balloon safari over the Mara is followed by a “bubbly” (champagne) bush breakfast (optional extra). Or, guests take an early-morning game drive, followed by a breakfast at the lodge. The rest of the morning is spent at leisure – possibly by the pool, overlooking the endless panorama stretched out before them. After lunch guests enjoy a late-afternoon game drive. Overnight stay is at the Ashnil Mara Camp. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 8: Monday (or Saturday) – Back to Nairobi

After breakfast at the Ashnil Mara Camp guest take a drive back to Nairobi to proceed with their own arrangements. *Meals: breakfast.*

Itinerary:

Day 1: Monday – Arusha, Tanzania

Guests are picked up at Kilimanjaro International Airport in Arusha and transferred to the Serena Mountain Village Lodge for a one-night stay, just outside the hustle and bustle of Arusha. The rest of the day is at leisure.

Day 2: Tuesday – Lake Manyara

After breakfast guests take a drive to Lake Manyara National Park, famous for its tree-climbing lions. Overnight stay is at the Lake Manyara Serena Lodge, which stands high on the bluff of a dramatic ochre and terracotta streaked cliff. It commands panoramic views across the volcano-studded floor of the Great Rift Valley. Afternoon game drive. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 3: Wednesday – Serengeti

After breakfast guests take a drive to the world-famous Serengeti National Park. Guests visit the circular Rondavel dwellings and winding paths of a traditional Masai village. An afternoon game drive follows. Overnight stay is at the Lake Manyara Serena Lodge. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 4: Thursday – Serengeti

An early-morning balloon safari over the Serengeti is followed by a “bubbly” (champagne) bush breakfast (optional). Or guests take an early-morning game drive, followed by a breakfast at the lodge. After lunch guests enjoy a late-afternoon game drive. Overnight stay is at the Lake Manyara Serena Lodge. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 5: Friday – Ngorongoro

Guests travel to the Ngorongoro Crater via Olduvai Gorge and check into the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge, which is perched on the jagged rim of the crater. Afternoon is at leisure. Overnight stay is at the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 6: Saturday – Ngorongoro

Guests drive down into the crater for a half-day of game viewing. The extinct volcano plays host to wildebeest, zebras, buffaloes, gazellas, elephants, rhinos and big cats. Then guests visit a local Masai village. Overnight stay is at the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge. *Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.*

Day 7: Sunday – Back to Arusha

After breakfast at the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge guest take a drive back to Arusha to proceed with their own arrangements. *Meals: breakfast.*
